
An overview of Our School


Phase 1 and phase 2 - site map



Phase 1

New Woodwork room with material preparation and machinery area

 Multi room ASD 'Hub' suite including classrooms, toilets, sensory room, general area, resource room and office



Phase 2

- Currently submitted for Planning Approval anticipated in December
- Consists of new Science lab, Music and Art rooms, eight classrooms, office, new female student toilets, disabled access toilet and store room
- Redesigning internally in existing building giving us a second new woodwork room, a new I.T. room and a new school library replacing room 6
- Two additional Guidance/Counselling offices on main corridor in school
- Hoped to start at end of January 2022

•Additional areas to be addressed

Staff facilities

Our school staff has grown proportionally with our student enrolment

Total staff of 80

 Insufficient space in which staff can work and prepare/correct class work

Not possible to separate work space from lunch space

Solution

Repurpose existing student canteen to work area for teachers

Increase number of available staff toilets

Install storage facilities for teaching resources

Create adequate space for whole staff meetings

Student Canteen

- Current canteen can hold 200 students.
 - Student numbers are 650 now
 - No facility to prepare fresh, hot lunches
 - Students don't have a general space to meet and relax in
 - No reduced mobility access as it's on first floor

Solution

Relocate student canteen to current hall

Install modern kitchen facilities

Create General Purpose area for students


School Multi Purpose Area

- Current hall is too small for the size of our school today
 - School cannot include PE as a Leaving Cert option due to current facilities
- Students doing PE have to rotate/take turns
- Inadequate space for basketball, soccer and indoor training
- Changing rooms too small
- Insufficient toilets and no disabled access toilet in hall
- Inadequate space to hold assemblies, exams, etc during school
- Insufficient space to develop and promote music, drama and dance in school

Solution

- Construction of a new Multi Purpose Arena
- Providing adequate space in which two PE classes can run simultaneously
- Adequate facilities for training of all school teams
- Suitable space for the holding of school musicals, drama and cultural events
- Available to community clubs and associations outside of school times for events, training of teams, etc.

- Reduced environmental impact to construct
